

Sexual Harassment Prevention Training for Supervisors

Enacted in September 2004, AB 1825 requires California employers with over 50 employees to provide sexual harassment prevention training every two years for those in supervisory positions. **It also requires that newly-hired or recently-promoted supervisors receive this training within six (6) months of hire/promotion.**

Attendees who satisfactorily complete the course earn a Certificate of Completion.

Who is a Supervisor?

Any individual having authority, in the interest of the employer, to hire, transfer, suspend, lay off, recall, promote, discharge, resign, reward or discipline other employees, or to direct them, adjust their grievances, or recommend that action, if exercise of that authority requires the use of independent judgment, not just merely routine or clerical in value [Govt. Code §12926(r)].
